 We are about 80% to our 2019 numbers, which is when our numbers were the highest. Transit currently has 9 routes. A few of those routes have sister routes. Transit also runs specials which

- are the school specials. The school specials are to help have the buses on routes not be so packed with kids.
- Anyone that is 18 and under ride the bus for free. Adults pay a dollar to travel through Yakima.
- The Transit budget is about 12 million which includes funding the fixed route system, Dial A Ride, and the Yakima Ellensburg Commuter.
- Transit in the last year has bought new buses for fixed route. The life expectancy for those buses is 12 years. All the buses get cleaned every night. If there is ever an issue with the buses cleanliness please give us a call and we will look into it.
- Holidays Transit is closed Labor Day (September 1<sup>st</sup>), Veterans Day (November 11<sup>th</sup>), Thanksgiving (November 27<sup>th</sup>), Christmas (December 25<sup>th</sup>)
- Halloween is also coming up, we do not take the day off but the drivers are allowed to wear costumes.
- With the Football season starting up the drivers get to wear their NFL team jerseys that they support when their team plays. Drivers do need to wear the city issued badge.
- ◆ Fair Shuttle- This year the fair shuttle will be on the weekends, when it is the busiest. It will be from the former Astria Hospital parking lot. The Target parking lot has new owners and they are not allowing us to do the fair shuttle out of that parking lot.
- We are planning for the new year to go to a bus map instead of the buses. We also have the app and you can check in real time where the buses are located. Yakimatranist.org has access to the live map of the buses.
- ◆ There are a few detours for the buses. Fruitvale has a detour and 72<sup>nd</sup> and Washington Ave has a detour. When we have detours we cannot go through privately owned parking lots and they cannot reverse at all it is in our policy that the driver cannot reverse on their own.
